## Kents Cavern wins national travel & tourism industry 'Oscar'

The Torquay-based, family-run attraction already holds the Best Attraction in Torbay and Crystal Palm Best Achievement Awards for 2005, so owner Nick Powe, the fifth generation of the family to own and operate the caverns, is delighted to have added more silverware to his trophy cabinet.

Nick, and his wife Sheena, attended the prestigious Gala Awards Dinner at the London Hilton, Park Lane last night (Wed 3 May) when the winners were announced by the Best Practice Forum's judges.

The Best Practice Forum's 'Business Excellence Awards' are keenly contested every year, and are some of the most prestigious and sought-after accolades in the hospitality, leisure, travel and tourism industry.

The awards only go to UK businesses that have demonstrated their willingness to adopt or adapt best practice in all aspects of their operation in order to raise their efficiency and their profitability. They show how innovative business practice can achieve outstanding success.

Commenting on winning the award, Nick Powe said today (4 May): **"We are all immensely proud and delighted to have won one of this year's Business Excellence Awards.**
