

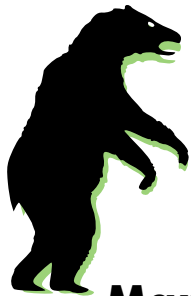
MISSING WORDS!

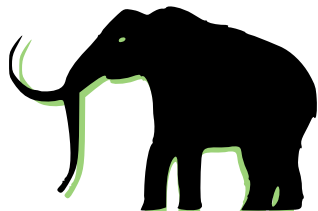
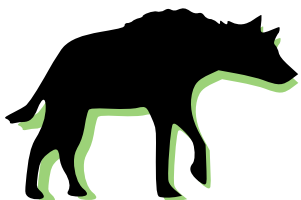
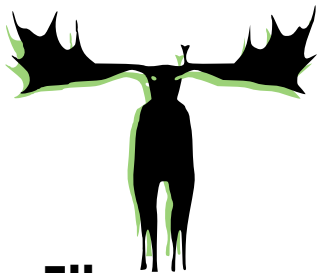
